

**APPENDIX B**  
**PERSONAL CARE SERVICES REQUIREMENTS**

**1. PHYSICAL DISTANCING**

- a. Personal Care Services must require and enable physical distancing between unassociated customers.
- b. Stylist/artist/provider stations and client chairs must be arranged in a manner that provides at least 6' of physical distance between other people in the establishment. The minimum distance of 6' is between people, not seats or stations. The placement of stations and chairs must accommodate movement of employees and clients through the establishment in a way that maintains at least 6' separation.

**2. SYMPTOMATIC INDIVIDUALS**

- a. Employers must take steps to ensure that employees know the symptoms associated with COVID-19.
- b. Employees with COVID-19 symptoms (even mild symptoms) are prohibited from being present in the workplace or serving clients.

**3. VISIBLE CUES**

- a. Personal Care Services must use visible cues to alert customers and visitors of the required 6-foot distancing requirements.

**4. CLEANING AND SANITIZING**

- a. Personal Care Services businesses must clean and sanitize commonly touched surfaces throughout the day.

**5. FACE COVERINGS**

- a. Service Providers must wear cloth face coverings or masks when providing services.
- b. Clients must wear cloth face coverings, except when receiving services that make a face covering impossible.

**6. REQUIRED SIGNS**

- a. If services offered require any clients to remove their face coverings, the business must post a sign at each entrance with the following wording: "Clients with COVID-19 symptoms (even mild symptoms) must refrain from entering."
